



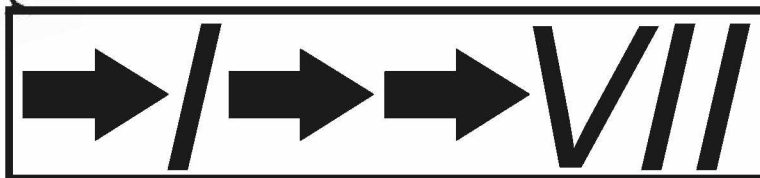
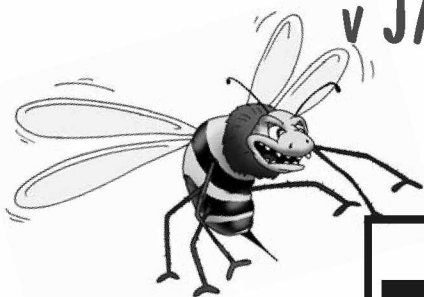

1. They **didn't have** the key. They **couldn't** open the door.

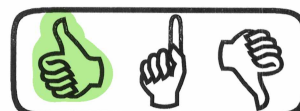
If they **had had** the key, they **would have been able to** open the door.

3. The sun **shone** yesterday. We **went** swimming.

If the sun **hadn't shined** yesterday, we **wouldn't have gone** swimming.



Nová gramatika: Prací věty

1) Přání přítomné se používá v těchto případech:

- a) Skutečnost je opačná, než si mluvčí přeje.
- b) Není jisté, zda situace, kterou si mluvčí přeje, nastane.



Věty jsou uvozené výrazy

IF ONLY = kdyby tak, kéž by

I WISH = kdyby tak, kéž by

V práci větě se používá **jednoduchá minulost**.

Poznámka: Stejně jako v češtině používáme minulý tvar slovesa:

Kéž by **Tom zavolal!** (*ale nevolá.*)

If only (I wish) **Tom called!**

Kéž bych **nezmeškal** ten vlak! (*nevím, zda ho zmeškám, nebo ne.*)

If only (I wish) **I didn't miss the train!**

I wish their parents understood them.

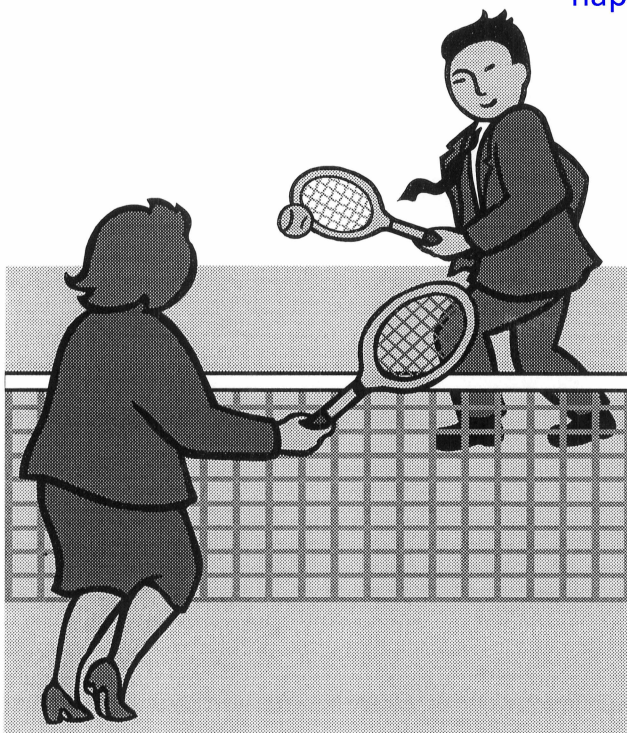
5. Diana **never listens** to me. (That's a shame.)

And it is true that most people would not admit that they are a bit xenophobic, or, in many cases, they may be xenophobic on a more subconscious level and don't really be aware of it at all.
