

John Winston Lennon was born on October 9th 1940 in Liverpool, England. As a child, John quickly became bored with school. He didn't do well at most of his subjects and it was only with the recommendation of his headmaster that he was able to secure a place at the Liverpool Art College. The college had not heard of John Lennon the musician He was accepted because of his drawings. It was there that he received his first guitar and taught himself to play. Rock and roll radio became his constant friend and teacher.

It was in 1957 that probably the greatest songwriting duo in history first with his group, the Quarrymen, met his future collaborator, Paul McCartney. The two hit it off immediately. While Paul had more of a pop approach to music, John was able to assert his underground music tastes. The world got something it had never heard or seen before: Beatlemania.
