






Tom is a devil. He has two horns, a long tail, a chain and a sack. He has some potatoes but he doesn't have any coal.




Tom: I don't have any coal. The devil should have some coal for the extremely naughty children.

**Do** we **live** in Prague? = Žijeme v Praze?

We **don't live** in Prague. = My nežijeme v Praze.

- 6) We **lived** in Rome.

**Did** we **live** in Rome? = Žili jsme v Římě?

We **didn't live** in Rome. = My jsme nežili v Římě.

- 7) He **asks** for your help.

**Does** he **ask** for your help? = Žádá tě on o pomoc?

He **doesn't ask** for your help. = On tě nežádá o pomoc.

- 8) She **asked** for it.

**Did** she **ask** for it? = Požádala tě o to?

She **didn't ask** for it. = Ona o to nepožádala.

- 9) You **invite** us.

**Do** you **invite** us? = Zveš nás?

You **don't invite** us. = Ty nás nezveš.

- 10) They **invited** our parents.

Did they **invite** our parents? = Pozvali oni naše rodiče?

They **didn't invite** our parents. = Oni nepozvali naše rodiče.
