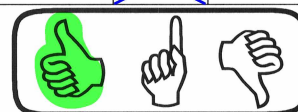
Well-behaved children **get** a bag or stocking full of fruits and sweets in the evening of December 5th.

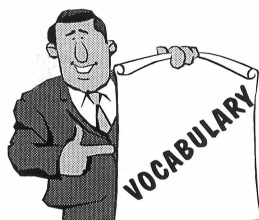

Tom is a devil. He has two horns, a long tail, a chain and a sack. He has some potatoes but he doesn't have any coal.

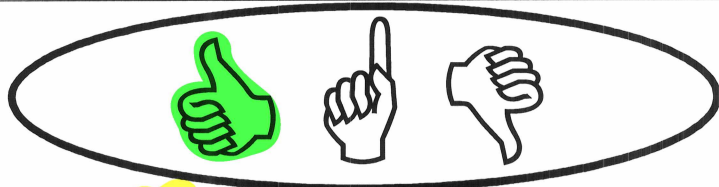
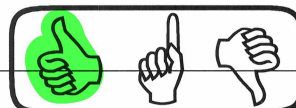
Tom: I don't have any coal. The devil should have some coal for the extremely naughty children.
