TEXT: "CHRISTMAS"

In Great Britain and the USA children **believe** that Santa Claus **brings** presents for them on Christmas Eve.

He **is** an old man with a white beard. He **wears** a red coat. He **lives** at the North Pole. On the night before Christmas he **travels** through the sky in his sleigh. His sleigh **is pulled** by his reindeer. Children **hang up** stockings in their bedroom on Christmas Eve. Santa Claus **comes** down the chimney and **puts** the presents in the stockings. In some homes it **is** the custom to leave a small glass of whisky or milk or a piece of Christmas cake for Santa Claus and a piece of carrot for his reindeer.

In the morning on Christmas Day, children **open** the small presents in the stockings. Larger presents **are** under the Christmas tree.

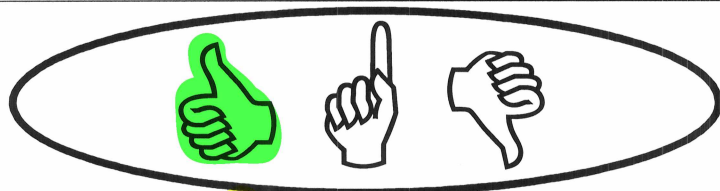

I haven't just offered them tea. = Já jsem jim ještě nenabídl čaj.
- 6) His mother has invited him home.
Has his mother invited him home? = Pozvala ho jeho matka už domů?
His mother hasn't invited him home. = Jeho matka ho ještě nepozvala domů.
- 7) They have prepared it.
Have they prepared it? = Už to připravili?
They haven't prepared it. = Oni to ještě nepřipravili.
- 8) She has translated it into Czech.
Has she translated it into Czech? = Už to přeložila do češtiny?
She hasn't translated it into Czech. = Ona to ještě nepřeložila do češtiny.
