2) Podmínka přítomná nesplnitelná						
Vedlejší věty jsou uvozeny spojkami						
(F = kdyby	GRAMMAR					
(UNLESS) = kdyby no	e, ledaže by)					
V hlavní větě se používá <u>podmínka přítomná,</u> ve vedlejší větě (po spojce IF nebo UNLESS) jednoduchá minulost.						
Skutečnost je opačná, než jak ji popis <mark>uje věta vedlejší, nebo je malá pravděpodobnost, že</mark> situace nastane.						
Kdyby pršelo , (ale neprší), If <u>it rained</u> ,	zůstali bychom doma. (ale nezůstaneme) we would stay at home.					
(Pomůcka: v angličtině se stejně jako v češtině používá po spojce minulý tvar slovesa.)						
<u>Vzal by</u> si taxi,	kdyby (náhodou) <u>nechytil ten autobus.</u> (Ale pravděpodobně ho chytí, takže si taxi nevezme.)					
He would take a taxi	if <u>he didn't catch the bus</u> .
